Dr Suter has been a member of the most prestigious global think tank in the world since 1993, The Club of Rome – comprising of only 100 members. He is a leading Australian academic and holds university qualifications in international politics, international law, international economics and ethics.

During the International Year of Peace in 1986 Keith was awarded the Australian Government's Peace Medal and in 1994, he was voted "Australian Communicator of the Year". More recently in 2007, Dr Suter was awarded the Australian Red Cross Distinguished Service Medal.
